

North Carolina State Fair Hunter Jumper Show is a Regular Member Competition of the USEF, with Hunter Rating of National A and Jumper Rating of Level 3\*. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Regulations of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therein. The show will adhere to USEF guidelines with regard to the minimum number of entries required to maintain a class.

<u>Association Sanctioning:</u> The North Carolina State Fair Hunter Jumper Show is sanctioned by NCHJA, VHSA, SCHJA, MHSA, NAL and WIHS. Prize list, Entry Blank, Host Hotels and Business Sponsors are posted on <a href="https://www.trianglefarms.com">www.trianglefarms.com</a>. Show announcements, schedule, start times and entry numbers during the show are posted on <a href="https://www.horseshowsonline.com">www.horseshowsonline.com</a>.

Entries: The Closing Date for entries is October 1st Late fee of \$50 begins after the Closing Date. Online entries are accepted at horseshowsonline.com. Visa, Master Card, American Express and Discover Credit Cards are accepted. All entries, showing and non-showing, must be made on the online entry blank on www.horseshowsonline.com, pay the Service Fee, and be signed by the rider, trainer and the owner or agent. Full payment, stall payment, open check or credit card information must accompany entries, along with copies of measurement cards and membership cards. All horses are required to have a USHJA Registration number. Entry fees, less the service fee of \$50, will be refunded on presentation of a veterinarian's certificate proving inability of the horse to show. Stall fees will not be refunded.

**Health Requirements:** A negative Coggins test dated within one year is required for each entry, required by NC State law. Current Coggins must be displayed on the horse's stall. All horses on the grounds must comply with and provide proof of vaccinations per USEF GR845. No numbers will be released from the Office without Coggins and Vaccination Proof.

Non-negotiable Checks: Checks returned for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$30 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, full payment including penalty must be paid in certified funds within 5 days. After 15 days, USEF will be notified.

<u>Prize Money/Refunds</u>: Prize money will be credited to the exhibitor's show bill. Any prize money in excess of the bill and refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the horse show.

<u>Measurement:</u> All Pony and Junior Hunter exhibitors must present their measurement cards at the Show Office before numbers will be released. Ponies and Junior Hunters without cards will be measured by a USEF Steward at the show.

Stabling: Permanent stalls with doors are available, beginning Monday Oct. 2 at 12 noon. The Stall Fee is \$275/stall. Stalls will not be reserved without full stall payment, open check or credit card information. No stall refunds will be made after the Closing Date of Oct. 1. Non-stabled horses will be charged a \$50 grounds fee. Trainers to complete and submit a Stabling Form for stall, feed & bedding orders by the closing date of Oct. 1. Trainer's Stabling Order Form required for all exhibitors, including entries submitted online.

<u>Feed, Hay and Bedding</u>: Pre-orders for feed, hay and bedding to be included on the Trainer's Stabling Order Form. All subsequent feed and bedding orders to be placed in the Show Office. All feed, bedding and tack stall splits must be completed by 12 noon on Friday.

<u>Class Entries and Schedule Changes</u>: To be posted at the show office and on <a href="www.horseshowsonline.com">www.horseshowsonline.com</a> at the close of the office each day. The management reserves the right to reschedule, combine, close, add, delete or move any classes or change the announced officials as may be necessary and in the best interest of the show or for inclement weather. A rotating jump order to be used in all classes over fences. At no time will the rings be held up over 3 minutes due to conflicts. Should any question or disputes arise that are not provided for in the rules, the Show Manager's decision will be final.

<u>Schooling</u>: Schooling will be permitted in all show rings on Tuesday from 10am until 5pm. Flat work available in all rings each morning of the show, to close 1 hour prior to start time. Ticketed Warm Up, \$25/ticket, to be available show days, schedule to be posted in the office. Lunging is not allowed in the show rings; lunging areas are available and to be posted.

<u>Camper Hook-ups:</u> Camper sites with water, power and sewer are available on a first come, first serve basis. Camper fees are collected by NC State Fair Security.

<u>Local Fire Regulations:</u> Parking of vehicles or horse trailers is not permitted in the fire lane adjacent to the stabling areas. NC State Fair Security patrols and tickets vehicles parked around the barns.

<u>Dogs and Cats:</u> All dogs and cats on the show grounds must be leashed and under control of the owner or responsible person. Violators will be fined \$100.

<u>Helmets:</u> Protective Headgear is required on all exhibitors when mounted on the grounds. Properly fitted protective headgear is required in accordance with USEF GR 801



Motorized Vehicles: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

<u>USEF Membership Statement:</u> Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies.
