Adeline's Story

When Adeline was born, her heart experienced arrhythmias. Her doctors weren't overly concerned, but as a precaution, they sent Adeline for additional screenings at Duke Children's. At Duke, Adeline's family received a staggering diagnosis.

Dr. Salim Idriss, a Duke pediatric electrophysiologist, diagnosed Adeline with Long QT Syndrome (LQTS), a rare and sudden arrhythmic death syndrome that is difficult to detect because the first symptom is usually death.

LQTS isn't curable, but it can be managed. Dr. Idriss put Adeline on a strict medication regimen. She also had open heart surgery when she was seven days old to implant a therapeutic pacemaker.

LQTS is a genetic disease, and because Adeline had it, it meant one of her parents did too. Dr. Idriss determined that Adeline's father, Aaron, was the carrier. It was a miracle that he was still alive, and he was quickly connected with a Duke cardiologist to manage his LQTS.

Aaron had unknowingly been living with LQTS his entire life. He realized that LQTS had been silently killing people in his family for generations. If not for Adeline, the same fate likely would have happened to him. Adeline wasn't only Aaron's first child, she ended up being his guardian angel.

Today, Adeline is nine and is happy and energetic. She enjoys arts and crafts, her favorite subject is science, and she loves musical theater. Despite facing this difficult disease daily, Adeline and her family stay positive and enjoy life to the fullest.

While Adeline's LQTS will never go away, her family has the tools, knowledge, and access to medical treatments that will keep her on track for a long, happy, and healthy life, thanks to Duke Children's.

Each year, Children's Miracle Network (CMN) Hospitals selects ten patients to represent the impact of its 170 member hospitals. Adeline has been serving in this role in 2024. Adeline and her family have attended special events throughout the country representing CMN Hospitals, like Duke Children's, meeting with corporate partners and sharing her personal story. We are so proud of Adeline and how wonderfully she has represented Duke Children's and kids like her!

2024 JUMP FOR THE CHILDREN Rules, Regulations & Procedures

ENTRIES: CLOSING DATE: :OCTOBER 23, 2024- stalls will sell out each week - do not wait to mail entries! Stalls are limited: once sold out, entries will be placed on the wait list in order of receive date. NO STALLL WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT A FORM OF PAYMENT AND THE STALL FORM HAVING BEEN RECEIVED BY SHOW.

Entries must be postmarked before midnight EDT on the date shown above to be considered on time. All entry blanks submitted will be charged a \$75.00 (nonrefundable nontransferable) Office/ Admin Fee. Scratches received after 10/23 will incur a \$50 scratch fee. Stalls are not refundable (unless the show is able to resell) after 10/24.

ONLINE ENTRY available at www.horseshowsonline.com

ENCLOSE Full stall fee, credit card information or an open check to reserve your stall. a \$125 deposit is required to reserve your entry.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted, if space permits, with a late entry fee of \$50 for entries received on or after November 1st. Horses showing in classes for which they are not entered will be charged DOUBLE ENTRY FEE. NO SAME DAY ADDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

PRIZE MONEY: All prize money in excess of balances due will be mailed to the **owner of record**, unless otherwise directed, within 30 days of the completion of the show. All prize money receiptients must submit a W9 to the show office to receive their prize money. It is the exhibitors responsibility to make sure they have submitted the correct payee information.

REFUNDS: Exhibitors shall be held responsible for entry fees of all horses entered by them or their agents. Stabling, nomination and application fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries, unless we are able to resell a stall. Refunds, by check, will be mailed after the show within 30 days.

FEES: Payment of all fees must be made in U.S. funds. American Express, Discover, MasterCard and Visa accepted, 3% convenience fee for using credit cards. There will be a service fee of \$75.00 OR 10%, whichever is greater, charged for each check or credit card returned for insufficient funds, uncollected funds, or any other reason for non payment.

CAMPER PARKING: Camper hook-ups are avaiable on the show grounds. No reservations accepted. NC State Fair security collects camper fees. Call NC State Security, 919-612-6767 when setup to confirm spot.

STABLING INFORMATION - No stall will be reserved without full payment, credit card information or an open check to secure it. Stalls are \$290/per stall, per week. Stall fees are non-refundable after the close of entries, unless we are able to resell the stall. All horses on the grounds, must have a completed entry blank on file in the show office and have paid the office fee and non-showing fee (if applicable). No sharing of stalls permitted without permission from management.

Box stalls are permanent wood (10x10)and temporary vinyl (9x9), with doors, housed in permanent buildings or under tents. **STALLS MAY NOT BE DISASSEMBLED OR ALTERED.** Exhibitors are responsible for any damage to stalls. No bedding provided. Horses residing in a stall and not competing in any classes, will be charged a \$125 non-showing fee, plus the \$60 office fee and must provide proof of vaccinations and coggins to the show office. **Night watch included in stall fee.**

Local Fire Regulations prohibit the parking of vehicles in the fire lane adjacent to the stabling area.

FEED AND BEDDING: All feed and bedding orders must be placed in the horse show office and will be billed to your account. Orders must be placed by 2 pm for same day delivery. Trainers wishing to split their feed and bedding bill, must do so in writing by noon Friday. Pick up orders are subject to a fee.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: A Negative Coggins Test dated within one year is required for each entry. ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS MUST COMPLY WITH AND PROVIDE PROOF OF VACCINATIONS PER USEF GR845. CURRNT COGGINS MUST ALSO BE DISPLAYED ON THE HORSES STALL. NO NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED FROM OFFICE WITHOUT COGGINS OR VACCINATION PROOF.

POLING: MANUAL POLING and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets is prohibited. Any rider or trainer who is found poling or using offsets, as well as the horse or pony involved, will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of the incident and will forfeit all entry fees.



EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFI-CATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

1-The Jump For The Children shows will adhere to USEF guidelines with regard to the minimum number of entries required to maintain a class.

2-Show Management reserves the right of declining to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable charges before or during the Show, without being liable for compensation.

3-The show will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendant, animal or equipment at the show.

4-All attendants coming in charge of horses will be subject to the order of Show Management and must have their horses ready to enter the Show Ring at least 30 minutes before the time for showing them.

5-Numbers will be provided at the Show and must appear on the entry while competing in the Show Ring. Must wear the number card provided by the show.

6-No person will be allowed in the Show Ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.

7-Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver or groom, shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.

8-Show Management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the Show without being liable for compensation.

9-No horse will be allowed in the Show Ring except at such hours as are announced.

10-Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to Show Management whose decision shall be final.

11-It is the tradition of the Show that riders and handlers be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Riders in all classes must wear headgear in accordance with GR801. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience and must bar riders without protective headgear from classes in which it is required.

12-All exhibitors must be current members of USEF or purchase a USEF show pass on usef. org. Exhibitors must current members of USHJA or pay the \$30 show pass fee.

13-All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter Sections must present proof of current USEF measurement before numbers can be picked up, except large junior hunters.

14-In all Hunter and Equitation classes Show Management reserves the right to limit the courtesy circle with the use of a dotted line.

15-Courses for all hunter classes will be over fences consisting of brush, aiken, post and rail, in and out, stone wall, coop and white gate and will be posted 30 minues prior to classes.

16-A rotating jump order will be used in all classes over fences.

17-Championships will be awarded in all Hunter and Jumper Sections according to USEF rules unless otherwise noted.

18-All horses showing in the equitation, hunter or jumper divisions must present current USHJA Horse Registration. USEF Horse Recording is required for any horse showing in any jumper class where prize money is \$25,000 or greater.

19-Management may fine exhibitors up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

2024 JUMP FOR THE CHILDREN

General Regulations

20- Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/ legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. 21-No Smoking is permitted in any buildings.

22-Dogs will not be permitted anywhere on the premises unless restrained on a leash. 23-Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7)assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

PARCEL DELIVERIES(UPS/FED-EX): Management will not be held responsible for mail or parcel deliveries made to exhibitors. Items sent should be clearly marked with the name of the recipient, not just the show. Packages will be accepted beginning **Monday before each show**.



The USHJA Hunter Team Challenge offers a unique team experience for riders competing in the 2'-2'6" Children's Pony Hunters, 2'6" Low Child/Adult Hunters and 3' Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter divisions. Riders who participate in the Hunter Team Challenge have an opportunity to earn bonus Zone Horse of the Year Points in their respective divisions.

To participate, riders must pre-enter with the horse show on a first come, first served basis. Sixteen riders in each of the three sections (Children's Pony, Low Child/Adult and Children's/Adult Amateur) will be accepted for a total of 48 participating in the HTC.

What to Expect: The Hunter Team Challenge will take place over two competitive days with a rider meeting the day before Day One.

Entering Procedure: Riders will enter directly with host Horse Show. Sixteen riders in each of the three sections (Children's Pony, Low Child/Adult and Children's/Adult Amateur) for a total of 48 participants will be accepted on a first come first serve basis from the entry deadline.

Rider Meeting: riders attend to review rules, scoring and draw of teams.

Day One: HTC classes will run concurrently with the horse show's regular division classes as an overlay.

Day Two: Under saddle will be held at the start of Day Two. Each height section will have their own under saddle class: 3' Children's and Adult Amateur, 2'6" Low Child and Adult, and Children's Pony.

Final Round: Will be held immediately following the under saddle on Day 2. All teams will return for a final Classic-style over fences round.

The Final Round will receive Ribbons 1st-8th, and the highest scoring rider from the Final Round will receive a trophy.

Overall HTC team award presentations to follow the individual placings from the final classic round.

Scoring: Riders will receive a numerical score 0- 100 from the two over fences rounds in their regular division classes on Day One. On Day Two Riders will receive a numerical score from their respective under saddle classes. A rider's overall score will be determined by adding together their numerical score received from their regular division classes on Day One and their score from the Team Challenge under saddle class on Day Two. In each phase, except the Final Round, the lowest team member score will be dropped.

All riders following the under saddle on Day 2 will return to the Final Round. Each rider will receive a numerical score 0-100 for their placing in the round. In the final classic round the highest scored rider from each Team will be doubled and added to the Final Team Score. All other scores will be dropped from the final classic round.

The Overall Team Champion is the team with the highest overall score from Day One, Day Two, and the Final Round.
