Show Details: Show Ring open for schooling 7:30-8:30am and at Lunch Break. Negative Coggins required and proof of Flu/Rhino vaccine within 6 months of show. ASTM/SEI approved show helmet required when mounted. Formal attire required. Dogs must be on a leash. All entries are made at the rider's, owner's, trainer's own risk. Neither Triangle Farms, Inc., nor the management shall in any way be responsible for the loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, equipment or vehicles brought to the show grounds. Entry constitutes agreement.

Class Specs: Assisted Walk/Trot, Walk/Trot, Walk/Trot/Canter and Wee Poles open to beginner riders. Beginner Crossrails open to riders in first two years of showing over fences. Novice Hunter open to beginner riders. Open Hunter open to all riders. Short Stirrup open to riders 12 and under, Long Stirrup open to riders 13 and over, both in first 2 years of showing. Triangle Hunter open to non-pro riders. All heights offered.

Champion Awards: Champion Ribbon and Award and Reserve Champion Ribbon to be awarded in each division at each show. Circuit Champion Ribbon and Award and a Circuit Reserve Ribbon to be awarded in each division at the final 2025 Schooling Show at the Farm on October 25.

Entry Fees: \$20 per class; \$25 per Feature class; \$30 Grounds Fee per entry and non-showing horse. Divisions to be split if entries warrant with Champion and Reserve to be presented in each section. All horses on the grounds must be entered.
